Fundraising for the Nepal Earthquake

The dreadful natural disaster of the Nepal earthquake touched everybody who saw the television coverage from the area and heard the horrific accounts of the survivors who were not only devastated at the loss of loved ones but had also lost their homes and possessions too. Albeit in a small way, Seaton House School wanted to help and so decided on a mufti fund raising day for a minimum donation of £1.



Teaching staff made a 'Giving Tree' and a leaf was exchanged for each donation brought in, so the children could write their name and message of support and hang it from the tree. Seaton House currently has 164 pupils and so we hoped to raise at least that much towards the disaster fund, but once again our parents, friends and family exceeded all expectations and on our mufti day the total donated reached an amazing **£1,251.19**. This money has been sent directly to The British School in Nepal to a personal contact of a member of our staff and so we are hoping that without any administrative delay this money will be soon helping those in most need.
