What we have been doing this week:

This week we have enjoyed decorating the Nursery ready for Christmas. I went to a Christmas tree farm on Saturday and cut down a tree for Nursery which seemed to impress the children. They had a great time decorating it too. On Wednesday we enjoyed a drama show by Aesop Theatre Company. They put on a show called 'The Gingerbread Man'. This was loosely based on the traditional tale but had a happy ending. The children have been making Christmas decorations and have enjoyed decorating the home corner as part of their role play. We have also been sharing Christmas stories in the book corner and at carpet time. In Nature Garden this week the children have been making Christmas decorations using natural materials. On Thursday we sent home a bag of Christmas goodies, we hope you enjoy them.

What we have planned:

Next week we will continue to think about Christmas and share stories and songs. The children will be making more decorations in the craft area and playing games outside. On Monday we have our new children visiting, Chloe and Dilanie are joining our Hedgehog class after Christmas. During the first full week we will be talking about our favourite toys and we would like the children to bring in a toy to show or a photograph if it is very precious. A letter will be sent home at the end of next week with some of the ideas planned for the spring term.
