**We hope that you have a lovely half term break and look forward to welcoming you back in June.**

We have a very busy few weeks planned up to the end of term. Below we have briefly outlined some of the planned ideas. These will be added to and more information will be given on our weekly newsletter.

As part of our Father's Day celebrations we would like **all the children** to bring in a photograph of their Daddy which they can share with the class. Please bring these in **by Friday 9<sup>th</sup> June**.

**Week.1** The Queen's official birthday. We will be reading the story 'The Queens Knickers' and talking about the Queen and what her role is. We will be looking at coins and other items with the Queen's head on and writing a letter to the Queen.

**Week.2** Sports morning and Father's Day. The children will be designing and making their own banners for their teams. We will be talking about the importance of supporting our team mates and encouraging them. We will also be talking about our Daddies in preparation for Father's Day.

**Week.3** Travel and transport. We will be thinking about the different ways we can travel, both in vehicles and using our bodies. The children will be doing traffic surveys, observational drawings, exploring the inside of a car and setting up a car wash and garage outside. In Rabbit class the children will be talking about what they have enjoyed at Nursery and what they are looking forward to doing as they move on the Reception class. They will also write a letter to their new teacher. Our story focus will be 'Giraffes Can't Dance' and we will talk about the different talents we all have and what we would like to learn to do better.

**Week.4** We are going on our trip to LadyLand Farm on 28<sup>th</sup> June. We will be using non-fiction texts and the internet to find out more information about farm animals and the children will report back their findings to the class. The children will also be describing animals for others to guess..

**Week.5** We are hoping to take the children on a trip to the local woods. The children will be going on a treasure hunt to find objects that we can then use to make pictures and models. We will also be taking all of the children on a trip to the main school. While we are there we will collect natural materials to look at back at Nursery. The children will be making some maps of their visits and talking about features in the local area that they like and dislike.

**Week.6** Graduation day on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> July at 9.15am, this is for all parents to attend and will last approximately 40 minutes.
