What we have been doing this week:

We have enjoyed decorating our Christmas tree and making Christmas decorations for the classroom this week. We have also been involved in a variety of Christmas art and craft activities. The children have continued to be busy in our Christmas shop and have been writing shopping lists and paying for items using pennies. We have had a parcel delivery service set up outside which has enabled children to further practise their number recognition and counting skills by delivering parcels to numbered "houses."

We have continued to practise our songs and poem for our Christmas show next Wednesday. The words have been sent home to enable your child to practise at home.

On Wednesday we saw a lovely performance of The Hare and the Tortoise by the Aesop theatre company. It was very entertaining and interactive and the children enjoyed it very much.
