Target: £2,017.00 - Total raised so far: £3,313.50

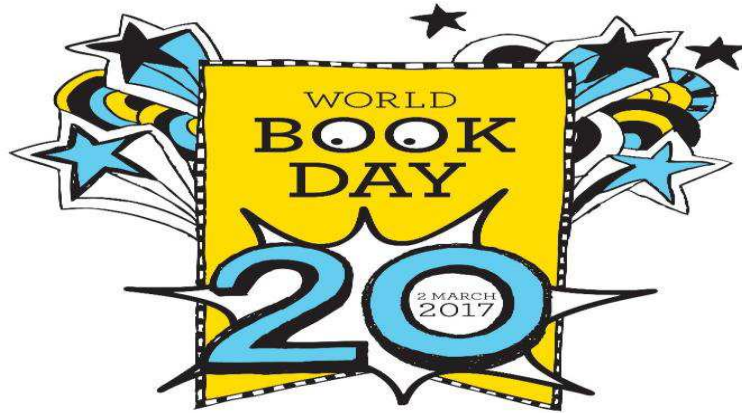

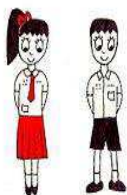
