Look at the celebration of festivals and ensure all faiths and cultures are represented.	International Day focused on parents within the school and encouraging them to come in and share information about their heritage and culture. Eid meeting for parents March 2024: arranged an assembly for the girls and families to share information about the celebration of Ramadan and Eid. Also a workshop session in each form run by parents. SS has created an overview of all festivals and sends weekly reminders to staff about celebrations and resources that could be used during Form Time.	
Review the purchase/booking of Breakfast club slots so this can be done weekly rather than half termly.	This has been reviewed and a new system will be in place for September 2024.	
Review the billing for ASC and do this in 30 minute slots rather than hourly.	This has been reviewed and changes will be introduced in September 2024.	
Could the gate be open for longer at 8.15 as some parents iss this opening by a few minutes and have to wait until 8.30.	From Easter SM and CB will be on the gate (SH and Early Years) each morning and the gate will be open from 8-8.40am. This will give all parents more flexibility in terms of drop off, reduce stress and hopefully improve parking.	
Review of the use of screens at school.	This was discussed with staff at school and a brief audit completed to assess the use of screen time.	
Can spellings be sent home for the whole term as the girls sometimes lose them weekly.	Spellings will be added to Google classroom each week so parents can download a spare copy. Parents emailed to let them know 13th March.	
Can creative homework and research projects have success criteria to help the girls?	This was discussed at staff meeting and agreed by staff (5th March)	
Could the school provide a park and walk service or drop off to ease congestions?	The school approached Chiltern Church 2 years ago to ask if we could hire their car park for the start and end of the day. They were unable to agree to this. We continue to explore opportunities.	CB to contact the Church again.
Can parents have more feedback regarding progress?	Parents have reports twice a year and parent meetinfs twice a year. They also have a Celebration of Work evening and are able to email staff to ask questions. The girls are set targets each term and these are in their home school diaries. Maybe we need to be clearer with parents where the targets are and how they can support learning at home.	
Concerns that some children do not wear the correct uniform.	We have been doing spot checks on uniform but we will now ask Form Teachers to do daily checks and send home a slip with pupils who are not wearing the correct uniform.	Staff all have slips to add to a child's bookbag to highlight any item of uniform that is incorrect.
More dance clubs.	We are exploring additional dance club providers to introduce in september 2024.	
Review food providers and improve lunches.	We have introduced a new food provider, lunches are now kept warm on site and served to the girls on plates rather than using packaging. The food is made fresh and provides a healthy option. Food is good quality and for those who are hungry, they can often have seconds. We have spoken to the provider about having a plain option each day which can be ordered by parents. This is in addition to the main and Veggie option each day. As a school we are exploring Health School status and would like to combine this with our focus on making our lunches more ECO friendly.
